

The Community Services Committee of the City Council for the City of Junction City met on Tuesday, April 7, 2015, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 680 Greenwood Street, Junction City, Oregon.

PRESENT WERE: Chair, Karen Leach; Councilor Herb Christianson; and Community Services Director, Tom Boldon

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair, Karen Leach called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

2. NEW BUSINESS

Proposed Senior Meals IGA Renewal 15/16

Director Boldon passed out a graph that had been sent from LCOG (Lane Council of Governments) to the Committee. He stated that it was a great agreement and he wanted to keep the relationship with them going to continue to offer the same services at Viking Sal.

3. CONTINUED BUSINESS

JC3.1 Run/Walk Fundraiser

Director Boldon updated the Committee on the progress of the 5K run/walk stating that would be held on June 6th. He received permission from West Linn Corporation, LLC who owns the land to have the event on their property. He still needed volunteers with course marshals and finish line help but was very excited about generating funds for the youth programs at the Community Center.

Parks: Parks Projects

Director Boldon stated that the Parks Committee had been preparing for the new community park at the Reserve. They had received the surveys back with a lot of great information that would be shared at the open house on April 18th from 1pm-3pm at the Reserve.

5. DEPARTMENT UPDATES

Library

Director Boldon had been updating the Library's policy and wanted to have that posted at the Library. They wanted to address dress code, hygiene, use of the public computer stations and what's viewed on them, loitering, and animals. He would take that to the Library Advisory Board, who would need to approve it, and it would then be brought to the Community Services Committee.

Parks

The restrooms at Laurel Park had been closed at night until further notice, due to the continued vandalism that had been occurring. Director Boldon was impressed with the teamwork of the Police Department, who closed the restroom every night, Parks Lead McClintock who opened the restrooms every morning, and the Public Works weekend staff who opened the restrooms Saturday and Sunday.

Director Boldon informed the Committee that they had been in the process of hiring a temporary seasonal worker for the Parks. They interviewed a good applicant and would be moving forward with that.

Pool

Director Boldon stated that the Manager position for the Pool had been posted and interviews would take place later in the month. The Pool Supervisor positions would be posted soon and the interviews would be in May.

Community Center

The Community Center hosted the 2nd annual Prom Dress Giveaway on April 11th and 12th. They had a lot of dresses available and were excited to be able to give them away.

Viking Sal

The Volunteer Appreciation Dinner was held April 15th to thank all of the volunteers who had given a lot of their time to Viking Sal.

The 2nd annual Country Swing Shindig was on June 28th at Christ's Center, who had offered their facility for this event.
