The Monthly Expenditure Report was viewed and discussed. We are at the 75% mark of the fiscal year, and expenditures are at 74.36%. The comment was made that the book money that we are not allowed to spend is going to city legal fees. The monthly statistics report that goes to City Council was reviewed.

On-going Business

- Soroptimists International of Junction City gave the library \$100 for Summer Reading Program -- 2016
- The Oregon State Library gives Junction City Public Library, along with all of the other libraries in Oregon receive an amount of money for Ready to Read projects, according to the population served. Junction City PL receives the minimum amount of \$1,000. In the past few years, this money has been spent on preschool theme kits. It was suggested that perhaps we could do some outreach with the money. Healthy Start, Head Start and the Relief Nursery would be well-served with family literacy training. Another suggestion is to have 'tween or teen boxes of all of the same books for reading groups. Lynn agreed to research what other libraries have done with their state library allotment.
