

The Sewer and Streets Committee of the City Council for the City of Junction City met on Monday, September 14th, 2015, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 680 Greenwood Street, Junction City, Oregon.

PRESENT WERE: Councilors Randy Nelson, Jim Leach and Herb Christensen; and Public Works Director Gary Kaping.

I. CALL TO ORDER

Councilor Randy Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm

II. CHANGES TO THE AGENDA

There were no changes to the agenda.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – August 3rd, 2015

The consensus of the Committee was to approve the minutes.

IV. 6TH STREET ADA PROJECT

Director Kaping stated that back before the Committee tonight is the 6th Street ADA Project. He noted that since it has been a few months since the City received the bids, he was going to get updated bids from all original bidders. Discussion followed.

The City is recommending awarding the jobs to the lowest bidder. Discussion followed.

ACTION: The consensus of the Committee was to uphold the Council's consensus and award the project. The Committee would also like Director Kaping to email Mr. Elizondo to inform him of the date of the removal.

V. NOTICE TO ABATE

Director Kaping informed the Committee that last month City Administrator Knope asked him to look into Municipal Code 8.10 and nuisance abatement. Director Kaping reviewed the documents and contacted City Attorney Connelly. He asked City Attorney Connelly to make the necessary changes needed to the Municipal Code to allow for the City to abate a nuisance. Before the Committee tonight are those changes. Discussion followed.

ACTION: The consensus of the Committee is to forward the Municipal Code changes to the Council with the recommendation to approve.

VI. AGENDA FORECASTER REVIEW

Director Kaping reviewed the Agenda Forecaster with the Committee. He noted that he will add the Rate Study to future business items. He then informed the Committee that he will bring Vista Dale back to the Council when he gets the report from City Engineer Henry.
