1. CALL TO ORDER

The Art class at the Junction City High School would be painting a new mural on the south side of the wall, inside the fence in the spring.

Community Center

The Sharing Tree at the Community Center was up and the tags should be on the tree by Friday, November 5th.

Viking Sal

Director Boldon reported that the Big Hush raised \$7,228.

Upcoming events for Viking Sal were; the Angel Tree would be up on December 1st, the Light Parade; which the Senior Center would have a float, would be December 11th, and the Breakfast with Santa would be December 12th.
