What to do, if you would like to apply for a Garbage Hauling License:

1. Please read JCMC 8.05.
2. Submit a **completed** application form and application fee (\$30.00 or \$40.00) to City Recorder or designee.
3. Staff and the Public Works Committee will review the application.
4. Upon recommendation of approval by the Public Works Committee, the application will go before the Council for final approval.
5. Upon successful approval, the license will be good for a period of three months and shall automatically be renewed for a subsequent quarter, as long as the licensee complies with all the standards and terms of the City Code.

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Chapter 8.05 GARBAGE REGULATIONS

Sections:

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8.05.010 Garbage defined.

“Garbage” as referred to in this chapter shall mean all sorts of animal and vegetable matter, rubbish, trash, debris, ashes, tin can and waste matter and shall embrace articles and things ordinarily and customarily hauled off and dumped for the purpose of promoting the health and cleanliness of the city. 8.05.020 License required.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to haul and dispose of garbage within the city of Junction City without first procuring a license therefor as hereinafter required, or to haul and dump garbage at any place except as designated by the common council. 8.05.030 Standards for granting license.

Licenses may be granted to those applicants who show a need for the service and the ability to provide equipment which comply with the regulations of the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality, and adequate personnel to fill those needs. [Ord. [883](#) § 1, 1985; Ord. [265](#) § 3, 1946.]

8.05.040 Application and fee.

A. Any person, firm or corporation, before engaging in the business of hauling and disposing of garbage in the city of Junction City, shall make application for and obtain license for the transaction of such business. Such application shall be filed with the city recorder and shall contain the name of the applicant, the apparatus and equipment proposed to be used in garbage hauling, the persons, firms or corporations whose garbage the applicant intends to haul, and such other data as may be pertinent.

B. Licenses shall be for a period of three months and shall be automatically renewed each subsequent quarter as long as the licensee complies with all the standards and terms of this chapter. The license fee shall be \$40.00 a month, payable quarterly. T

first payment shall be at the time of filing application for the license.

C. Such application filed with the recorder shall be by him presented to the council at its next meeting for action of the council and a majority vote of the council shall be sufficient for the granting of such license.

D. Additional persons, firms, or corporations may be added to those a licensee serves during any one quarter by first obtaining the approval of the council.

E. Any person, firm or corporation before engaging in the hauling of garbage limited to paper products shall make application for and obtain license for the hauling of such products in a manner prescribed in this section, except that the license fee shall be \$30.00 for each three-month period. The licensee shall not charge for its hauling services. Nonprofit organizations are exempt from the requirement that they obtain a license and pay a fee as set forth in this section.

F. Licensees which collect any of the following materials shall, not later than 15 days following each calendar quarter, submit to the city the quantities of material they pick up within the city, according to each of the specified categories: container glass, flattened tin cans, household aluminum, used oil, newspapers, corrugated cardboard and craft paper bags. 8.05.050 License constitutes agreement.

The securing of a license by an applicant shall in itself constitute an agreement that such applicant will haul garbage for the persons, firms or corporations approved by the council and none others. [Ord. [583](#) § 2, 1971; Ord. [265](#) § 5, 1946.]

8.05.060 Rates.

The rates to be charged to all persons, firms, or corporations shall be reasonable and uniform, taking into consideration the service rendered, as established by [resolution](#) of the city council. 8.05.070 Rates by hour or load.

Commencing June 20, 1984, the charges for removal of garbage and refuse by the hour or the load shall be as follows, and shall apply only where the material cannot by its nature be conveniently placed in containers of the types previously mentioned in this chapter:

A. Hourly rates:

1. Open bed truck and one man	\$32.20 per hour
2. Open bed truck and two men	43.27 per hour
3. Packer 20 yards and under – one man	43.27 per hour
4. Packer 20 yards and under – two men	54.26 per hour
5. Front-end loaders and one man	54.26 per hour
6. Front-end loaders and two men	65.33 per hour
7. Chipping fee	79.00 per hour
8. Brush pickup/hauling fee	62.75 per hour

B. Load, trash at curb, with no item to exceed six feet in length:

1. Truck and one man	\$43.27 per load
2. Truck and two men	54.26 per load

8.05.080 Supervision.

Regulation and disposal of garbage and hauling of the same in Junction City shall be under the supervision of the sanitation/recycling committee of the city council. [Ord. [1050](#) § 4, 1998; Ord. [768](#) § 4, 1979; Ord. [265](#) § 8, 1946.]

8.05.090 Time and manner for disposal.

All persons, firms or corporations shall be required to dispose of all perishable garbage which may become offensive or may have become offensive within one week from the time of production, and to dispose of nonperishable and nonoffensive garbage promptly, and shall not permit same to accumulate upon or about the premises, and shall dispose of the same by either burning or burying in such a manner as not to create a nuisance, or by hauling or causing same to be hauled to the garbage dump designated by the city authorities. 8.05.100 Transportation by person responsible.

Any person may transport garbage produced by himself or herself upon the streets without procuring license, and without complying with the regulations imposed on licensed haulers; provided, that such garbage must be hauled in such a manner as to prevent leakage or litter on the streets and must be deposited at the designated dump grounds. 8.05.110 Vehicle regulations.

No licensed garbage hauler shall transport garbage in the city except the same be kept in a covered, watertight and drip-proof vehicle, equipped with metal body which equipment shall be sterilized daily with live steam; provided, that innocuous substances may be conveyed in suitable conveyances with provisions against litter by coverings. 8.05.120 Property owner responsible.

The property owner of record shall be responsible for the payment of the garbage service fees prescribed by this chapter for services rendered by the city in accordance with the provisions of JCMC [8.05.140](#). [Ord. [956](#) § 2, 1991; Ord. [822](#) § 1, 1981; Ord. [265](#) § 14, 1946.]

8.05.130 Charges at premises.

All charges for garbage service furnished by the city within the city shall be chargeable to the user at such premises where the garbage services were supplied. [Ord. [1050](#) § 5, 1998; Ord. [956](#) § 2, 1991; Ord. [822](#) § 1, 1981; Ord. [265](#) § 15, 1946.]

8.05.140 Delinquent accounts.

Where the user of the services is 20 days delinquent in the payment of garbage service fees, a notice shall be mailed to the user and to the property owner of record, if different than the user, notifying the user and the property owner that garbage service will be suspended if the delinquent bill has not been paid in full within 10 days. The notice shall also state that if the delinquent bill has not been paid in full within those 10 days, the garbage service charges shall become a lien on the premises 20 days from the date of the notice. Any lien created shall be an entry on the ledger or other records of the city pertaining to its garbage services, and such ledger record or other records shall remain accessible for inspection by anyone interested in ascertaining the amount of such charges against the property. The lien hereby created may be foreclosed in the manner provided for by ORS [223.610](#), or in any other manner provided by law or city ordinance. [Ord. [1050](#) § 6, 1998; Ord. 8.05.150 Inspection.

The city through its proper health officer and health authorities shall have the right at any time to inspect all equipment or apparatus of any licensed garbage hauler and to inspect the city dump ground and the manner of keeping the same and upon failure of any licensed garbage hauler to abide by the terms of this chapter and the rules and regulations prescribed under this chapter. The common council may upon proper notice and hearing revoke the license of such licensed garbage hauler. [Ord. [265](#) § 11, 1946.]

8.05.160 Penalties.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter may upon conviction thereof in the municipal court be fined not to exceed \$100.00. [Ord. [373](#), 1959; Ord. [265](#) § 12, 1946.]
