

The Community Services Committee of the City Council for the City of Junction City met on Tuesday, April 3, 2018, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers, 680 Greenwood Street, Junction City, Oregon.

PRESENT WERE: Councilor Rob Stott, Councilor Kara McDaniel, Community Services Director Tom Boldon, and Community Services Coordinator Gina Moore. **Absent:** Chair Jack Sumner

1. CALL TO ORDER

Councilor Rob Stott called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.

2. CHANGES TO THE AGENDA

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The Committee consensus was to approve the minutes for March 6, 2018.

4. DEPARTMENT LOGO UPDATE

Community Center – Spring Break Review

Eight kids attended camp for the week and had a lot of fun. We anticipate more kids for summer camp. The Prom Dress Giveaway would be Sunday, April 8th at the Community Center and April 29th at Along Came Trudy.

Senior Center – LCOG/Senior Meals; Director's Office

LCOG had terminated the agreement with the City and would provide a staff person for the Senior Meals programming. This was due to Marcia's pending retirement, as she worked with Senior Meals as well as Viking Sal.

Director Boldon would be moving his office down to Senior Center within the next few weeks.

7. CSC AGENDA FORECASTER REVIEW

There were not a lot of items for the next agenda.

8. OTHER BUSINESS

Council member Bill DiMarco informed the Committee that seniors in high school needed volunteer hours and could help at Viking Sal or Library if needed. He also discussed a snack shack at the pool with Ophelia's Place volunteers working in it.
