

The Public Works Committee of the City Council for the City of Junction City met on Monday, July 29th, 2019, at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 680 Greenwood Street, Junction City, Oregon.

PRESENT WERE: City Public Works Director Gary Kaping, Councilors Dale Rowe and Bill DiMarco.

ABSENT WERE: Councilor John Gамbee.

I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Dale Rowe called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

II. CHANGES TO THE AGENDA

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – June 1, 2019

The consensus of the Committee was to approve the minutes as written.

IV. GARBAGE TRUCK PURCHASE

Director Kaping stated that before the Committee tonight is a request to purchase a garbage truck from General Equipment. Based on the City's truck replacement policy, it is time replace one of the automated trucks. Director Kaping informed the Committee that the City has demoed five separate trucks and have narrowed the selection down to two: the Bridgeport and the Curbtender. After weighting all the options, the City believes that the Curbtender is the best option. Discussion followed.

ACTION: The consensus of the Committee was to forward the request to the Council with the recommendation to approve the purchase of the Curbtender.

V. AGENDA FORECASTER REVIEW

Director Kaping added the garbage truck to current business.
Director Kaping will add Safe Routes to School and the Event Property to future business.

Councilor DiMarco asked if there were any updates from legal on the building at 7th and Ivy.

Director Kaping responded that he spoke to legal last week and they will reach out directly to the insurance company to see if they could get any movement.
