



Junction City Parks - Summer Recreation Hot Spots

Bailey Park

Acreage: 2.6 acres. East end of Bryant Street. 50' high Oak trees define the edge on the west and south boundary at the perimeter of an open lawn area with a pathway running through. A playground is located on the southeastern corner with two play structures and benches at its perimeter. The park includes two tennis courts and tot swings.



Tequendama Park

Acreage: 0.5 acres. Timothy So. off of W 6th. Tequendama Park is located adjacent to Junction City High School. A bike/pedestrian path is located along the eastern boundary of the park. Additionally, two pathways extend to Shara Place and Saxon Place. A pathway also extends east from the park along the south side of the High School. The park includes playground equipment as well as a small basketball court.



Oak Meadows Park

Acreage: ~ 0.77 acres. Yew North of off W. 10th. Oak Meadows Park was constructed as a part of a new subdivision development. The park includes play structure and basketball court with a path into and around the park space surrounding an open lawn area. The landscaping utilizes a wide range of plant species providing seasonal interests.



Laurel Park

Acreage: 1.45 acres. Laurel Park is located next to the Junction City Municipal Swimming Pool (Max Strauss Pool), and Laurel Elementary School at 14th and Kalmia. The park includes two shelter areas. The larger shelter structure has enclosed rooms on either side of an open court area. The smaller shelter structure is a gazebo and includes sink, electrical outlets and picnic tables. The gazebo is available for rent. If interested please contact the City Recorder at 541-998-2153 for rental.



Toftdahl Park

Acreage: ~ 0.87 acres. 15th and Laurel. The park is surrounded by single family homes to the north, the Municipal Swimming Pool to the south, Dutch's field to the east and School District athletic fields to the west. The park is connected to 17th Avenue though a bike path. The park includes a play structure and basketball court.



Junction City Parks - Summer Recreation Hot Spots



Dutch's Field

Acreage: ~ 1.9 acres. 14th & Kalmia.

The field has bleachers, small press-box, electronic scoreboard and field lights for nighttime play. There is a parking lot between the field and the Max Strauss Pool to service the field as well as on-street parking. Dutch's Field is available for rent. If you are interested please contact the City Recorder at 541-998-2153.



Founders Park

Acreage: 0.25 acres.

Founders Park is located in the middle of downtown Junction City at 5th and Holly Streets. The park includes the 1905 Finnish locomotive #418. The park is used as a focal point for the City's annual Scandinavian Festival and provides a seating area and Veterans memorial placard.



Bergstrom Park

Acreage: 2.0 acres. 5th and Dorsa.

Bergstrom Park is surrounded by farmlands to the north and east. A bike path extends to Alder Street from the park providing an alternative access point. The park includes a small basketball court, play area updated in 2012 and a wall for tennis or wall ball.



Lyle Day Park

Acreage: 2 acres. Between 5th and 6th Avenues and Elm and Deal.

A pedestrian path meanders through the open lawn with pedestrian lights connecting the two streets. The park includes a tennis court, half basketball courts and playground equipment.



Raintree

Acreage: .5 acres. SW Pine and Kaylee

This neighborhood park features two play structures designed specifically for two age groups. The first for 2-5 yr olds and the second for 5-12 yr olds. These two play areas are separated by a recreational basketball court.



Junction City Skatepark

The Junction City Skatepark located in Laurel Park offers street style and ramp based skateboard opportunities for all skill levels in an open and visible park setting. The Junction City Skatepark was funded through community donations, community events, business contributions, individual donors, and grants. The Skatepark is available for rent. If you are interested please contact the City Recorder at 541.998.2153.




