This list is not all-inclusive; it is provided as a guide for homeowners. Should you wish to plant a species not on the list, this can be accommodated.

Small Trees – 30 feet or less

Small trees are classified as those reaching 30' or less at maturity; medium 30'-50' & large over 50'.
